# Background Information

- Atlanta VAMC
  - One of the fastest growing VAMCs in the Nation
  - Joint Commission accredited
  - Magnet Recognition
  - Expanding into multi-specialty clinics
- Ft McPherson
  - VA acquired six buildings and 10 acres
  - Property transfer from DOD was effective February 2012
  - Four “historic eligible” buildings
  - Most medical programs will relocate from other VAMC facilities
  - Will have about 250 staff (about 75 are new staff)

# Under Renovation

- Building 125 (Lawrence Joel VA Clinic)
  - Phase I completed by December 2012
  - Phase II completed by March 2013
- Building 129 (Community Resource and Referral Center, CRRC)
  - Coordinating with State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO)
  - Completed by March 2013

# Under Renovation

- Building 131 (Domiciliary)
  - Coordinating with SHPO
  - Completed by March 2013
- Building 132 - demolished

# Activations

- Building 125 (Lawrence Joel VA Clinic)
  - Phase I between January – February 2013
  - Phase II between March – April 2013
- Building 129 (CRRC) by April 2013
- Building 131 (DOM) by April 2013

    - Lab

# Support Programs

- Building 129 (CRRC)
  - Community, State and Federal agencies
  - 17 agencies have filed a notice of intent
- Building 131 (DOM)
  - 40 beds
  - Domiciliary Residential Rehab Treatment Program (DRRTP)



# Future Renovations

- Building 128 (Healthcare for Homeless Veterans, HCHV)
  - Construction funds received
  - Start date: 2012
  - Completion: Summer 2013
  - Relocating from East Point
- Building 130
  - Design funds received
  - Expansion of SATP
